Over the course of the season, Kristina blogged about the growth of the children and caregivers in her class as they all made music together. By week three, she writes:


"Everyone was very keen and happy to be there...The caregivers were 100% attentive, participating in every song with joy and feeling...The babies really responded to the extra adult enthusiasm...There is a strong rapport developing between myself, the shelter workers, the parents and the children."

Having taught at Robertson House since January, Kristina had a chance to really bond with the families who participated in the program. It made a huge difference to the kids and parents to have RSF classes as a constant in their lives. So, from now on, we will run programs for two consecutive sessions (about 20 weeks) in each shelter we serve

This summer, we're taking another big step! RSF will run classes in two shelters in the same session for the very first time. Matthew, another fantastic Rainbow Songs instructor, will run the program at June Callwood Centre and Alana Kurtis, a Rainbow Songs instructor, will spend the season at Beatrice House.

New Saturday Classes On Roncesvalles!


