For other signs of illness, please use your discretion when deciding whether to attend class. If *you* are sick and possibly contagious, please consider either missing the class, or arranging for another caregiver to bring your child.

We encourage you to use the hand sanitizers provided in each classroom. Regular use can drastically reduce the spread of illness.
