

## Rainbow Songs Foundation - Making a Difference in 2011

Rainbow Songs Foundation was established in 2007 to provide the same high-quality music classes you've become familiar with through Rainbow Songs to families with small children living in the City of Toronto's shelter system.

Since then, Rainbow Songs Foundation has grown every year, offering more and more weekly music classes and working with a larger number of shelters – to date we have provided music education to families at seven different shelters. In 2010, we also launched a pilot project to bring music to families residing in one of Ontario's social housing communities. This means an ever-growing number of children and families have a weekly opportunity to laugh and sing, while learning new songs and about new instruments.

For shelter participants, it is an enriching and nurturing experience that helps families bond, learn, and grow together – a valuable program that might not otherwise be affordable or accessible.

This is all thanks to you! The foundation relies heavily on its dedicated team of volunteers and leaders and the charitable donations it receives from individuals and corporate sponsors to make it all happen. Building on the success of previous fundraising events, 2011 is shaping up to be another busy year for the foundation with the following events:

October – The third annual Hands Together fundraising concert. Last year's show sold out quickly, so stay tuned for ticket details!

November – The Perfect Click family photo event. This is a great opportunity to have a family portrait taken by a professional photographer, and just in time for the holidays.
