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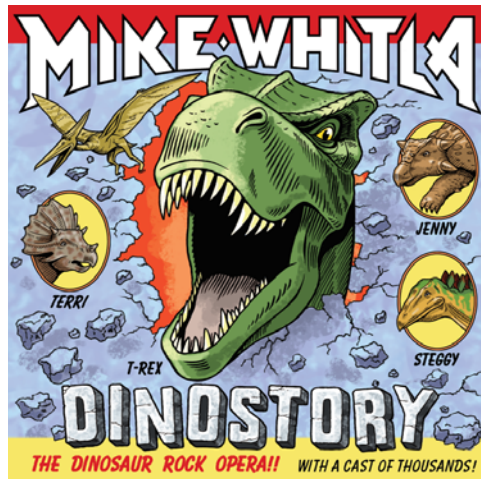
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**DINOSTORY:

Sickness Policy

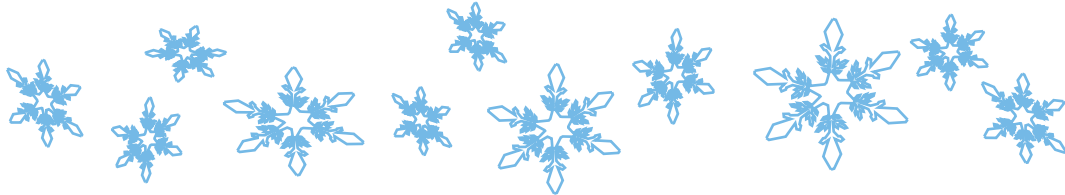
It's now cold and flu season. To keep everyone as healthy as possible, we'd like to remind you of our sickness policy.

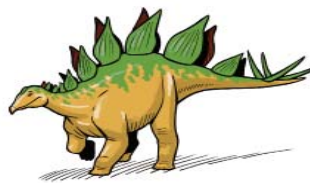
