Ontario Children's Activity Tax Credit

Beginning in late 2010, the Ontario Ministry of Finance created a tax credit for parents to reimburse them a portion of the cost put towards children's sports and artistic activities. Your enrollment in Rainbow Songs' sessions is eligible for this tax credit.

As per the ministry website, parents can "claim up to \$509 in elgible expenses and get up to \$50.90 back for each child under 16 for 2011" (*source: www.fin.gov. on.ca/en/credit/catc/index.html*)

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Experiences From a Rainbow Songs Foundation Music Instructor

Jessica Blake, one of the Rainbow Songs Foundation's (RSF) music instructors, shares her experiences teaching the classes RSF provides to families with young children using homeless and domestic abuse shelter services in the Greater Toronto Area.

"My experience working at the June Callwood Center has been enriching, and so different from my regular Rainbow Songs classes. I have been working with teen moms and their babies and toddlers, and have been able to witness how difficult it is for these very young moms to balance the needs of their growing children, while going to school and trying to find time for themselves to grow and mature.

Over the past 13 weeks of working with different moms and their children I have noticed that the moms are starting to feel safer in the music class environment and they are starting to trust me more. They are beginning to lose their inhibitions, which results in their more active participation in class – which benefits the children. With each week that passes I am able to do more challenging songs and teach them more challenging rhythms on the drums, maracas, and tambourines. They are always excited to see what Instrument of the Week I have brought and they have proven to be very talented at being able to play the different instruments from around the world.

I am so grateful for my experiences at the June Callwood Center and I know that through the challenges of teaching there I am becoming a stronger leader and more importantly I can feel that I am growing as a person."
