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Rainbow Songs Launches Pre-natal Music Workshop this Fall!

Rainbow Songs is excited to announce an upcoming 3-part workshop series that will teach expectant parents how to use music to communicate, connect, grow and bond with baby before and after birth.

Led by veteran instructor (and mom) Jessica Blake, the series will give participants an underlying undstanding of how pre-natal music works, a singing repetoire, basic baby sign language skills, as well as a sense of well being and confidence!

Why pre-natal music? All children are musical from birth. We can further develop this innate talent by bonding, connecting and interacting with our baby in musical ways while they are in utero. The skills and songs learned will benefit both caregivers and baby and will give you lifelong positive memories and repertoire.

Did you know? The baby's ear is the first sense organ to develop and hearing is one the most developed senses in the womb. Post birth, singing and sharing music strengthens the emotional bond between caregiver and infant because it releases oxytocin (which causes feelings of trust), dopamine (feel good hormone), and prolactin (hormone that bonds people).

Singing to your infant is your child's first language lesson and can prevent language problems later in life, helps them learn how to discriminate sounds, helps speech development, and improves memory and concentration later on. Babies recognize their parents' voices after birth and newborns prefer their parents' voices over the voices of strangers

There are benefits for expectant moms too! Music has been seen to reduce high stress levels, anxiety, and depression that many pregnant women experience during their pregnancy. When a woman relaxes, that's good for the fetus! Singing also increases moms' lung capacity and oxygen flow, helps reduce pain, opens up sinuses and respiratory passages, decreases blood pressure, and tones facial and abdominal muscles!

Where, when, how much: Workshops will take place at our Roncesvalles location (277 Roncesvalles Ave). Begins mid-November, dates TBA. Cost is \$120 per family for 3 x 75-minute sessions.
